### TRAVEL

How to reach Münster by air

There are several possibilities to travel to Münster by air:

Münster/Osnabrück Airport (FMO)

From here buses run every 30 minutes to the main station in Münster. The journey takes around 35 mins. and costs €5.60

Düsseldorf Airport

From here trains run regularly to Münster, though you may have to change at either Hamm, Dortmund, Duisburg or Essen. The journey takes between 1hr 15 m to 1h 55m and a single ticket costs between €22 and €30 depending on the connection.

Cologne/Bonn Airport

From here trains run regularly to Münster, though you may have to change at either Köln Messe/Deutz, Cologne or Hamm. Trains run every 20 – 30 minutes and take about 2hrs 20min. Single tickets cost between €27 - €36.

Dortmund Airport

Buses run every 20 mins to Holzwickede station. From here trains run regularly to Münster taking between 45mins and 1 hr, though you may have to change in Hamm.

Weeze Airport

Unless you plan on hiring a car, this is not so convenient with public transport and the journey to Münster takes around 3 hrs. You would either have to get the bus to Kevelaer station then change at Krefeld or get the bus to Weeze station, then change at Düsseldorf and/or Dortmund. Single tickets cost between €27 – €36.

Paderborn/Lippstadt Airport

Buses run regularly from here to Paderborn station. Trains take between 1hr 50min – 2hrs 20 min, possibly changing in Hamm. Single tickets cost around €20.
